**THREE HOUR FACILITATED TOUR. ► RECOMMENDED FOR 7<sup>TH</sup> GRADE AND ABOVE.** Students actively explore the dynamics of prejudice and discrimination historically and today. Promoting critical thinking and youth empowerment, trained docents lead students through interactive exhibits that address themes such as the power of words and images, human rights, and the history of the Holocaust. Each student receives a photo passport card that reveals the story of a child whose life was changed by the Holocaust.
