

## **Official Rules**

Starting on October 2, 2017, Dana-Farber Cancer Institute and the Jimmy Fund (“DFCI”) will invite eligible participants via email, Facebook (<http://www.facebook.com/TheJimmyFund>), Twitter (<https://twitter.com/TheJimmyFund>), the Program website (<http://www.rallyforthejimmyfund.org/>), and other methods to support the 2018 Rally for the Jimmy Fund program (the “Program”). Participants who: (i) visit the URL reflected in the invitation, (ii) supply all requested information in a complete and accurate fashion and (iii) submit a contribution to DFCI (online via <http://www.rallyforthejimmyfund.org/>, or offline via a check made payable to DFCI mailed to 10 Brookline Place West, 6th Floor, Brookline, Massachusetts 02445) as described below on or before April 19, 2018 at 5:00pm EST will be entered into a drawing for a chance to win a prize as described below.

The drawings will be held at DFCI: 10 Brookline Place West, 6th Floor, Brookline, Massachusetts, on April 19, 2018 at 05:01pm EST. The Senior Vice President for Development, or her/his designee, shall be responsible for drawing at random the name of one (1) potential winner per drawing.

The potential winners will be notified by phone, mail and/or email. If a potential winner cannot be reached after ten (10) days from the first notification attempt, or if a participant is found to be ineligible, or if the notification is returned or undeliverable, or if a participant declines “winner” status, that participant will forfeit all rights as the winner, and an alternate winner will be selected. In the event the alternate winner declines the prize, the prize may be designated for another DFCI fundraising event at DFCI’s sole discretion. The prizes will be shipped via a traceable method of delivery.

In order to be eligible to participate in the drawing, a participant must, as of the date of entry: (i) be eighteen (18) years of age or older, and (ii) be a legal resident of one of the fifty (50) United States or the District of Columbia. Directors, officers and employees of DFCI, and persons otherwise affiliated with DFCI, are not eligible to win the prize; this includes immediate family members of any of the aforementioned groups. The term “immediate family” includes spouses, siblings, parents, children, grandparents, and grandchildren, whether as “in-laws,” or by current or past marriage(s), remarriage(s), adoption, co-habitation or other family extension, and any other persons residing at the same household whether or not related.

**NO PURCHASE OR CONTRIBUTION NECESSARY TO ENTER.** Maximum of one (1) entry per participant. Maximum one (1) prize per participant. The odds of winning depend on the number of valid entries received. Participants who make a contribution to DFCI between fifty dollars (\$50) and ninety-nine dollars (\$99), or submit an “entry form” as described above, will be entered into a drawing for a chance to win a Jackie Bradley Jr. autographed baseball, with a fair market value of one hundred ninety-nine dollars (\$199). Certificate of authenticity not included.

Participants who make a contribution to DFCI between one hundred dollars (\$100) and one hundred ninety-nine dollars (\$199), or submit an “entry form” as described above, will be entered into a drawing for a chance to win a tour of Fenway Park for up to six (6) people. This prize has a fair market value of ninety-six dollars (\$96).

Participants who make a contribution to DFCI between two hundred dollars (\$200) and two hundred ninety-nine dollars (\$299), or submit an “entry form” as described above, will be entered into a drawing for a chance to win one (1) Fielding Package at the 2018 John Hancock Fenway Fantasy Day at Fenway Park in Boston, Massachusetts. Each Fielding Package has a fair market value of seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750) and includes the following for one (1) participant: thirty (30) minutes of on-field fielding practice, breakfast or lunch, John Hancock Fenway Fantasy Day t-shirt, Jimmy Fund hat, exclusive access to the Boston Red Sox dugout including a professional photograph of the participant and grandstand admission for up to ten (10) guests (food and dugout access is limited to the on-field participant only). The date and time of the John Hancock Fenway Fantasy Day will be announced at a later date to be determined by DFCI.

Participants who make a contribution to DFCI of three hundred dollars (\$300) or more or submit an "entry form" as described above, will be entered into a drawing for a chance to win a personalized Jimmy Fund baseball jersey with the winner's name imprinted on the back of the jersey. This prize has a fair market value of forty-six dollars (\$46).

All entries must be complete to be eligible. Deadline to enter is April 19, 2018 at 5:00pm EST.

Prizes are non-transferrable, non-refundable, non-negotiable, not redeemable for cash or for re-sale, and no substitution will be allowed. Prizes will not be replaced if lost or stolen. Other restrictions may apply. Should a prize become unavailable to DFCI for any reason, DFCI reserves the right to substitute an item of equal or lesser value. If the prize is date-specific, the winner must be available on the date(s) specified. Winners may be required to sign an affidavit of eligibility, a receipt, a Certificate of Intent, and/or a waiver form provided by DFCI, prior to receipt of the prize.

Any valuation of the prizes stated above is based on available information provided to DFCI, and the value of any prize awarded to a winner may be reported for tax purposes as required by law. Winners are solely responsible for reporting and paying any and all applicable taxes related to a prize and for paying any expenses associated with a prize which is not specifically provided for in these Official Rules. Winners may be required to provide DFCI with valid identification and a valid taxpayer identification number or social security number before the prize will be awarded. Any person winning over \$600 in prizes from DFCI may receive an IRS form 1099 shortly following the end of the calendar year and a copy of such form will be filed with the IRS. Any person winning \$5,000 or more in prizes from DFCI may be required to pay the applicable taxes to DFCI before any prize will be awarded, per IRS regulations.

By participating in a drawing described above, participants agree to abide by all terms of these Official Rules and all decisions of DFCI, made in its sole discretion, which decisions shall be final. DFCI will interpret these Official Rules and will resolve any disputes, conflicting claims or ambiguities concerning the rules or the drawing, and DFCI's decisions concerning such disputes shall be final.

All participants, their heirs, executors and administrators, waive, release and forever discharge DFCI, all sponsoring entities, their respective trustees, directors, officers, employees, and agents, from all claims of liability, damages and rights of action of whatever nature or description, in equity or at law, present and future, that may arise out of or relate to participation in the drawing, including the use of any prize.

DFCI is not responsible for lost or stolen prizes, incorrect or inaccurate transcription of entry information, for any human error, technical malfunctions, lost/delayed data transmission, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, theft or destruction or unauthorized access to, or alteration of, entries, for line failures or other failures of any telephone network, server, providers, computer equipment, software or any combination thereof, for inability to access any web site or online service or any other error or malfunction, or for late, lost, illegible, misdirected or incomplete entries which may limit a participant's ability to participate in the drawing.
