Thanks to the efforts and generosity of our corporate partners and our community, Children's Miracle Network was able to endow a chair in Orthopaedic Movement Analysis at The Children's Hospital. The success of this endowment is visible in every detail of the newly designed Center for Gait and Movement Analysis (CGMA). The new CGMA builds on the strengths of the original facility, the region's first and only clinical gait analysis laboratory, by adding improved services and measurement capability for both children and adults, in a more open and comfortable environment for patients and their families.

Improved features include:

- ◆ Upgraded equipment including a state-of-the-art Vicon real-time motion capture system, wireless muscle activity recording and a high-definition video analysis system.
- ◆ Spacious waiting area with "porthole" windows at the perfect height for curious siblings to view the laboratory action and a 47" LCD television used for patient and family education and entertainment.

The new and improved CGMA will provide therapeutic and diagnostic care for patients with cerebral palsy, spina bifida, muscular dystrophy, limb deficiencies and amputations and congenital and genetic abnormalities. In addition to implementing the expert clinical care that allows patients the simple gift of movement, CGMA will continue its ground-breaking research in the understanding and treatment of these debilitating disorders.
