Calvary Hospice is a Medicare/Medicaid certified program that provides comprehensive palliative and end-of-life care for patients with advanced and life-limiting illnesses.

Calvary Hospice provides short-term inpatient care at The Dawn Greene Hospice, located on the 15th floor of the Mary Manning Walsh Home on Manhattan's Upper East Side. Care in this 10-bed unit is intended for patients whose symptoms and care needs cannot be met at home.

The Dawn Greene Hospice is a partnership between Calvary Hospital and Mary Manning Walsh Home. Their joint mission is to help patients find peace and comfort near the end of life, and to assure family and friends that their loved ones are receiving clinically expert and compassionate care.

Mary Manning Walsh Home

ArchCare at Mary Manning Walsh Home has long been the residence of choice for families on Manhattan's East Side seeking top-quality residential care and short-term rehabilitation for those they love. The Carmelite tradition of providing innovative and patient-focused care to the most vulnerable among us is aligned perfectly with Calvary's core values of compassion, care, dignity, and non-abandonment.

Patient Care Program

The following program of care is available to Calvary patients at The Dawn Greene Hospice.

- Fulltime Calvary Hospice Medical Director (Board Certified in Hospice and Palliative Care)
- Hospice and Palliative Care trained nursing, social work and pastoral care providers
- 10 newly renovated **private rooms** with **private bathrooms**
 - Complimentary cable television and telephone service
 - Overnight accommodations for family members in patient rooms
- State-of-the-art patient care equipment
- Therapeutic Music Program and Complimentary Therapies (coming soon)
- Bereavement Support Program
- Family room with refrigerator, microwave oven, and coffee maker
- Multi-faith Chapel
- 24/7 visiting hours
- Free WIFI service

We encourage patients to bring their own toiletries, clothing, and other meaningful items such as pictures of family and friends.

Admissions Requirements

To be considered for The Dawn Greene Hospice, patients must:

- Be eligible for Hospice inpatient level of care;
- Require inpatient care for symptoms and care that cannot be managed effectively in another setting; and
- Need short-term inpatient care.

Referring Patients

Hospitals, physicians, nurses, and other health care professionals can make referrals or inquiries directly to Calvary Hospice. We encourage families of prospective patients to contact us with any questions. We offer on-site evaluation by a Calvary clinician.
