## The Museum of Tolerance

### Atrium Reception Area

The striking 40-ft high Atrium provides an elegant setting for large or small receptions, or seated dinners. Coupled with



the Peltz Theater, this reception area is the perfect companion for premieres.

### Peltz Theater

The sophisticated Peltz Theater comfortably seats 320 people. It is a great venue for live televised events, film screenings,



lectures, staged readings, conferences and debates. The Peltz Theater is equipped for 35mm, 16mm video and DVD projection.

## Educational Center

### Classrooms

Flexible multi-use spaces can be used as one large classroom, or subdivided. Accommodates from 30 - 110 people. Features internet connection, VHS, DVD Player, LCD Projector, projection screen and balcony access.



### Theater II

State of the art semicircular theater equipped with touch screen control of audiovisual equipment built into a custom podium. Theater II is equipped with multi-standard VCR, DVD Player, LCD Projector, motorized screen, 2 Plasma Screens, internet connection and video conferencing. Each of the 68 seats has a fold down desk, network connection and AC power source.



### Theater III

Beautiful, contemporary 119 seat theater with touch screen control of the audiovisual equipment built into a custom podium. Theater III is equipped with multi-standard VCR, DVD Player, LCD Projector, motorized screen, internet connection and video conferencing.
