- Use your boss' fundraising web page to send out e-mails to notify co-workers, clients and customers about the plan to "Toss your Boss." Be sure to ask them for your support by making a contribution towards the \$1,000 fundraising goal.
- Announce this event, as well as the progress towards your \$1,000 "Toss your Boss" goal on your company website, Facebook page, or newsletter. Don't forget to let people know how they can make a contribution!
- Post a Donation Sheet in the break room. Designate a location within your company where people can drop off donations.
