WFUNA has over 100 members, national United Nations Associations (UNAs) – connecting hundreds of thousands of people in every region of the world to the United Nations. Every encouragement is given to people interested in setting up a new UNA in member states of the UN where one does not yet exist....for example new UNAs have recently been established in Afghanistan, Cambodia, Benin, Mozambique and Pakistan.

When they join the World Federation, UNAs are entitled to use the UN Logo. The only NGOs accorded this privilege, UNAs have a unique role to play at the national level in:

- ▶ Disseminating information and educational materials about the United Nations
- ▶ Lobbying the government, political parties and interest groups in support of the UN
- ▶ Conducting Model UN conferences
- ▶ Stimulating the media to provide frequent and accurate coverage of the UN and its programs
- ▶ Collaborating with other national voluntary organizations on projects related to the work of the UN
