

## **Official Rules**

On May 24, 2010, Dana-Farber Cancer Institute (“DFCI”) will offer to its constituents a chance to participate in two (2) opportunity drawings by purchasing tickets to the Fan Zone via the Jimmy Fund website at <http://www.jimmyfundfantasyday.org>. Individuals who choose to enter both drawings as described below must obtain their tickets to the Fan Zone or submit all requested information to DFCI, which must be received by DFCI on, or before Friday, July 23, 2010 at 12:00 pm EST. Individuals who choose to enter only the second drawing as described below must obtain their tickets to the Fan Zone or submit all requested information to DFCI, which must be received by DFCI on, or before Friday, August 6, 2010 at 12:00 pm EST.

Individuals who purchase tickets to the Fan Zone or complete an “entry form” as described below, and provide all requested information to DFCI on or before Friday, July 23, 2010 at 12:00 pm EST will be entered into a drawing for a chance to win the following: a batting package which includes fifteen (15) pitches off a machine on the field at Fenway Park, a Fantasy Day t-shirt, a Jimmy Fund jersey, a Jimmy Fund hat, warm-up privileges in both the visitor’s batting cages and dugout, and a personalized DVD of your at-bat. These individuals will also be entered into a second drawing for a chance to win the fielding package described below. All individuals who purchase tickets to the Fan Zone or complete an “entry form” as described below, and provide all requested information to DFCI on or before Friday, August 6, 2010 at 12:00 pm EST will be entered into a drawing to win the following: a fielding package which includes thirty (30) minutes on-field, a Fantasy Day t-shirt, a Jimmy Fun hat, and a photographic memento. Should these prizes become unavailable to DFCI for any reason, DFCI reserves the right to issue similar item(s) of equal or greater value. The first drawing will be held at DFCI: 10 Brookline Place West, 6<sup>th</sup> Floor, Brookline, MA 02445 on Monday, July 26, 2010 at 1:00 pm EST. The second drawing will be held at DFCI: 10 Brookline Place West, 6<sup>th</sup> Floor, Brookline, MA 02445 on Monday, August 9, 2010 at 1:00 pm EST. The Sr. Vice President for Development, or her designee, shall be responsible for drawing at random the name of one potential winner.

Participants must be 18 years of age or older, and a legal resident of one of the 50 United States or the District of Columbia, as of the date of entry in order to be entered into the opportunity drawing(s). Directors, officers and employees of DFCI are not eligible to participate in this drawing nor to receive the prize. No purchase necessary to enter. Maximum one entry per person, per drawing. The odds of winning depend on the number of valid entries received.

Utilizing the respondents’ mailing addresses, phone numbers, and/or e-mail addresses reflected in the information submission, DFCI will contact the potential winners to notify them of their status as potential winners. If the potential winners cannot be contacted by the aforementioned means or does not respond to the notification within ten (10) business days, or the prize notification is returned or undeliverable, those individuals will forfeit all rights to any prize, and alternate winners will be selected at random on Monday, August 23, 2010 at 1:00 pm EST. The prize(s) will be delivered to the winners via UPS or another traceable method of delivery.

The winner of the drawing held on July 26, 2010 will receive a batting package with fair market value of two hundred dollars (\$200). The winner of the drawing held on August 9, 2010 will receive a fielding package with a fair market value of fifty dollars (\$50). Income and other taxes, if any, are the sole responsibility of the winner. The winners will be required to complete and return a Certificate of Intent before DFCI is able to release the prize(s).
