

Memorandum

RE: Smaller County Exception

Enrolled Voter Registration participants in the Chartered Organization Voter Registration Program from the smaller counties listed on the bottom of this page, in which Democratic registration is less than 20,000, as of October 23, 2006, may submit batches of 50 or more registrations for payment, rather than the minimum 100 which is required in more populous counties. Counties that do not qualify for the exception must submit batches of at least 100 registrations.

This rule change was made in response to concerns that small counties are not able to collect 100 registrations as quickly as more populous counties, and that this unfairly disadvantages them since funds are distributed in priority order, based on the date the request is post-marked (earliest requests submitted are paid).
