What time does Memory Walk start?

9:30 am Registration
10:30 am Walk Begins

Will handicap parking be available at Memory Walk?

Yes, however you must have a visible handicap parking sticker. Parking attendants will direct you to the handicap parking area

Can I bring my children to Memory Walk?

ABSOLUTELY, Memory Walk is an event for the entire family

Are pets allowed?

Yes, however they must be on a leash at all times and be of a non-aggressive nature

What constitutes a team?

A team is any group of family, friends, co-workers, classmates, faith or civic organization members, etc. who come together to raise money and awareness for the cause. Teams can be any size but we encourage teams to have at least 10 members – remember there is strength in numbers. Teams with large numbers of walkers (20+) may want to consider dividing into sub-groups and competing against each other. For example, a large company may want to have a team from each department to generate friendly competition among the team members rather than have one large team.

Does everyone have to register for Memory Walk or just team captains?

EVERYONE must register for Memory Walk. Pre-registration is now through three days before walk day and can be done online at www.georgiamemorywalk.org or by completing a registration form and returning to the Alzheimer's Association. Anyone not registered by three days before walk day will have to register at the walk. **You must be registered in order to receive t-shirts and/or other walker incentives**

Who completes the registration forms?

Team Captains register their team and then every team member must register themselves under the team's name either online or by completing a registration form

If I am pre-registered do I still need to register at the walk?

If you have already registered for the walk you will simply need check-in at the Pre-Registration table as you enter the walk to receive your breakfast ticket, hand-stamp and walk-day materials

Can teams raise money together as a collective group or does each team member have to raise their own donations?

Either way is fine...some teams even do a combination of both. Just keep in mind a few things:

- If team members want to earn t-shirts and/or other walker incentives the donations they raise must be turned in & recorded under their name

- Money from a collective team fundraiser (yard sale, etc.) can be divided among the members of the team in order to count toward t-shirts/incentives but this must be communicated to the Alzheimer's Association representative at the time the money is turned in – preferably noted on the donation envelope

How does each team member track donations?

Donations received online will automatically be credited as they are received. Team members can monitor these donations by visiting the team's webpage on the Memory Walk website. Team captains will provide all team members with a walker envelope to collect of made by cash or checks. These envelopes should be turned in to the team captain prior to the walk day to be included in the Team envelope that the team captain will present to the Alzheimer's Association. All cash and check donation will be recorded on the team's webpage once they are received by the Association

What is the deadline for turning in donations to count toward winning Team and Walker Awards?

All donations received no later than 10:30 a.m. on walk day will be counted toward awards that will be presented prior to the Closing Ceremony

How do walkers earn t-shirts and other incentives?

T-shirts are available to walkers that raise a minimum of \$150. Other walker incentives are available for walkers that raise more than \$150. A complete listing of incentive levels and prizes can be found on the website at www.georgiamemorywalk.org

What is the deadline for turning in donations to count toward earning t-shirts and/or other walker incentive prizes?

All donations must be received no later than one week after the walk to count toward earning t-shirts and other incentives
