

Official Rules

Starting on October 16, 2018, Dana-Farber Cancer Institute and the Jimmy Fund (“DFCI”) will invite eligible participants via e-mail to support the 2018 Sunrise to Sunset Jimmy Fund Golf Tournament held on October 15, 2018 at the International Golf Club in Bolton, Massachusetts (the “Event”). The registered participant who raises the highest amount of funds between October 16, 2018 at 12:01am ET and December 31, 2018 at 11:59pm ET, as determined by the Jimmy Fund Golf Program staff, is eligible to receive the prize described below (the “Contest”).

The Contest winner will be determined at DFCI: 10 Brookline Place West, 6th Floor, Brookline, Massachusetts, on January 2, 2019 at 12:00pm ET, The Senior Vice President for Development, or her/his designee, shall be responsible for determining the name of the potential winner.

The potential winner will be notified by phone, mail and/or email. If a potential winner cannot be reached after five (5) business days from the first notification attempt, or if a Participant is found to be ineligible, or if the notification is returned or undeliverable, or if a Participant declines “winner” status, that Participant will forfeit all rights as the winner, and an alternate winner will be selected. In the event the alternate winner declines the prize, the prize may be designated for another DFCI fundraising event. The prize will be shipped via a traceable method of delivery.

In order to be eligible to win the prize, a Participant must, as of the date of entry: (i) be eighteen (18) years of age or older, (ii) be a legal resident of one of the fifty (50) United States or the District of Columbia and (iii) be a registered participant for the Event.

The registered participant whose fundraising total, as determined by the Jimmy Fund Golf Program staff, increases by the greatest amount between October 16, 2018 at 12:01am ET and December 31, 2018 at 11:59pm ET is eligible to receive One (1) Complimentary Round of Golf for Four (4) Individuals at The Carnegie Abbey Club in Portsmouth, Rhode Island. Valid through the 2019 season; blackout dates may apply. Please refer to certificate for instructions on booking (certificate will be sent upon the completion and receipt of the signed Certificate of Intent form). Original certificate must be presented upon redemption. Certificate is non-transferrable, non-refundable, and not redeemable for cash or for resale. Certificate will not be replaced if lost or stolen. Expiration date will not be extended. Other restrictions may apply. This prize has a combined fair market value of one thousand dollars (\$1,000).

All entries must be complete to be eligible. Deadline to enter is December 31, 2018 at 11:59pm ET.

Prize is non-transferrable, non-refundable, non-negotiable, not redeemable for cash or for re-sale, and no substitution will be allowed. Prize will not be replaced if lost or stolen. Other restrictions may apply. Should the prize become unavailable to DFCI for any reason, DFCI reserves the right to substitute an item of equal or lesser value. Winners may be required to sign an affidavit of eligibility, a receipt, a Certificate of Intent, and/or a waiver form provided by DFCI, prior to receipt of the prize.

Any valuation of the prize stated above is based on available information provided to DFCI, and the value of any prize awarded to a winner may be reported for tax purposes as required by law. Winner is solely responsible for reporting and paying any and all applicable taxes related to the prize and for paying any expenses associated with a prize which is not specifically provided for in these Official Rules. Winner may be required to provide DFCI with valid identification and a valid taxpayer identification number or social security number before the prize will be awarded. Any person winning over \$600 in prizes from DFCI may receive an IRS form 1099 shortly following the end of the calendar year and a copy of such form will be filed with the IRS. Any person winning \$5,000 or more in prizes from DFCI may be required to pay the applicable taxes to DFCI before any prize will be awarded, per IRS regulations.

By participating in the Contest described above, Participants agree to abide by all terms of these Official Rules and all decisions of DFCI, made in its sole discretion, which decisions shall be final. DFCI will interpret these Official Rules and will resolve any disputes, conflicting claims or ambiguities concerning the rules or the Contest, and DFCI's decisions concerning such disputes shall be final.

All Participants, their heirs, executors and administrators, waive, release and forever discharge DFCI, all sponsoring entities, their respective trustees, directors, officers, employees, and agents, from all claims of liability, damages and rights of action of whatever nature or description, in equity or at law, present and future, that may arise out of or relate to participation in the Contest, including the use of any prize.

DFCI is not responsible for lost or stolen prizes, incorrect or inaccurate transcription of entry information, for any human error, technical malfunctions, lost/delayed data transmission, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, theft or destruction or unauthorized access to, or alteration of, entries, for line failures or other failures of any telephone network, server, providers, computer equipment, software or any combination thereof, for inability to access any web site or online service or any other error or malfunction, or for late, lost, illegible, misdirected or incomplete entries which may limit a Participant's ability to participate in the Contest. DFCI is not responsible for technical, hardware or software failures of any kind, lost or unavailable network connections or failed, incomplete, garbled or delayed transmissions.

The Contest is governed by the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. By participating in the Contest, each Participant consents to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts located in Suffolk County, Massachusetts, for resolution of all disputes.
