

Official Rules

On May 16, 2016, Dana-Farber Cancer Institute and the Jimmy Fund (“DFCI”) will host the 2016 Tame the Tigers golf tournament to be held at The International Golf Club in Bolton, Massachusetts (the “Tournament”). As part of the Tournament, DFCI will conduct a golf ball drop as described below (the “Golf Ball Drop”). Starting April 1, 2016 and ending on May 16, 2016 at 12:00pm EST, DFCI will promote the opportunity to enter into the Golf Ball Drop via the Tournament website (www.tamethetigers.org), email blasts to past and present Tournament participants, Facebook (<http://www.facebook.com/TheJimmyFund>), Twitter (<http://www.twitter.com/TheJimmyFund>), and WEEI radio advertisements. In order to participate, participants must purchase one (1) or more numbered golf balls (online via the Golf Ball Drop registration form on the Tournament website, or on the day of the Tournament at the registration table) (the “Participants”). All requested information must be submitted in a complete and accurate fashion in order to be eligible to participate. Participants may purchase one (1) numbered golf ball for twenty-five dollars (\$25) or three (3) numbered golf balls for fifty dollars (\$50). Following entry, Participants will receive the number(s) corresponding to their purchased golf ball(s) via email or at time of purchase at Tournament registration. For each golf ball purchased, Participants will receive one (1) entry into the Golf Ball Drop for a chance to win the prize described below.

The Golf Ball Drop will occur on May 16, 2016 at or around 4:00pm EST as described herein. All entries received between April 1, 2016 and May 16, 2016 at 12:00pm EST will be included in the Golf Ball Drop. The Golf Ball Drop will occur on a temporary golf hole set-up by the Tournament and The International Golf Club, and restricted from all groups including, but not limited to, all participants, spectators, course staff and DFCI staff during the Golf Ball Drop (the “Restricted Zone”). The Golf Ball Drop will utilize a professional helicopter company to fly over the Restricted Zone with a bin containing all numbered golf balls, hover above the Restricted Zone at an approximate height of twenty (20) feet above the ground, and release the golf balls simultaneously over the Restricted Zone. The numbered golf ball that lands closest to the pin within the Restricted Zone will be eligible to win the prize described below. In the event of a tie, the numbered golf ball closest to the bottom of the hole will win. The Sr. Vice President for Development, or her/his designee, shall be responsible for determining the name of one (1) potential winner.

The potential winner will be announced on May 16, 2016 at 6:00pm EST at the Tournament after the conclusion of the Golf Ball Drop. The potential winner does not need to be present at the time of the announcement to claim her/his prize. The potential winner will also be notified by phone, mail and/or email on May 17, 2016 at 12:00pm EST. If a potential winner cannot be reached after five (5) days from the first notification attempt, or if a participant is found to be ineligible, or if the notification is returned or undeliverable, or if a participant declines “winner” status, that participant will forfeit all rights as the winner, and an alternate winner will be selected. In the event the alternate winner declines the prize, the prize may be designated for another DFCI fundraising event at DFCI’s sole discretion. The prize will be shipped via a traceable method of delivery.

In order to be eligible to participate in the Golf Ball Drop, a participant must, as of the date of entry: (i) be eighteen (18) years of age or older, and (ii) be a legal resident of one of the fifty (50) United States or the District of Columbia. Directors, officers and employees of DFCI, and persons otherwise affiliated with DFCI, are not eligible to win the prize; this includes immediate family members of any of the aforementioned groups. The term “immediate family” includes spouses, siblings, parents, children, grandparents, and grandchildren, whether as “in-laws,” or by current or past marriage(s), remarriage(s), adoption, co-habitation or other family extension, and any other persons residing at the same household whether or not related.

NO PURCHASE OR CONTRIBUTION NECESSARY TO ENTER. Maximum of fifty (50) entries per participant. The odds of winning depend on the number of valid entries received. Participants who register for the Golf Ball Drop as described above, or submit an “entry form” to DFCI as described above, on or before May 16, 2016 at 12:00pm EST, will be entered to win the following prize package:

- One hundred forty thousand (140,000) AAdvantage Miles on American Airlines ("AA"), redeemable for any qualified awards outlined by AA (e.g. flights, flight upgrades, vacation packages, car rentals, hotel stays & other retail products).
 - Relevant Limitations: AAdvantage Miles expire two (2) years after being issued. AAdvantage Miles must be deposited into AAdvantage account before the expiration date. AAdvantage Miles are valid for eighteen (18) months upon deposit into AAdvantage account. To prevent miles from expiring, winner may renew miles with qualified account activity (e.g. earning or redeeming miles). Winner must sign up for AAdvantage account in order to deposit and use AAdvantage Miles at www.aa.com/enroll or by calling the AAdvantage Desk at (800) 882-8880. Certificates may be used by winner, his/her spouse, or dependant child. Miles are SAAver miles. A mileage cap may apply. Please allow up to seventy-two (72) hours for mileage to be credited to AAdvantage account. Blackout dates may apply when booking. Booking fees, luggage fees, and food & beverage fees are not included. Other fees may apply. Please refer to www.aa.com or call the AAdvantage Desk at (800) 882-8880 for rules & restrictions of participant AAdvantage affiliations and for additional pertinent restrictions. No open tickets are permitted. It is strongly suggested that travel arrangements are made early to ensure the best selection of flights.
 - Fair market value of this prize is three thousand eight hundred dollars (\$4,130)
- A three (3) night stay for four (4) individuals at the Reunion Resort and Spa in Orlando, Florida, a AAA Four Diamond Resort. The stay includes:
 - Complimentary three (3) bedroom superior villa accommodations for four (4) days, three (3) nights (resort taxes and fees included);
 - One (1) complimentary round of golf for four (4) people;
 - One (1) complimentary round of FootGolf for four (4) people;
 - Complimentary one (1) hour spa treatments for four (4) people on day of choice. Subject to availability (guests are responsible for upgrade/add-on charges in spa treatments);
 - Breakfast daily for four (4) people (excludes date of arrival);
 - Prize is valid through May 16, 2017. Guests are responsible for all other charges not mentioned as part of the above prize package. Blackout dates are subject to change and include, but are not limited to, all major holidays.
 - Fair market value is of this prize is four thousand three hundred thirty dollars (\$5,000).

All entries must be complete to be eligible. Deadline to enter is May 16, 2016 at 12:00pm EST. Prize is non-transferrable, non-refundable, non-negotiable, not redeemable for cash or for re-sale, and no substitution will be allowed. Prize will not be replaced if lost or stolen. Other restrictions may apply. Should the prize become unavailable to DFCI for any reason, DFCI reserves the right to substitute an item of equal or lesser value. The winner may be required to sign an affidavit of eligibility, a receipt, a Certificate of Intent, and/or a waiver form provided by DFCI, prior to receipt of the prize.

Any valuation of the prize stated above is based on available information provided to DFCI, and the value of any prize awarded to a winner may be reported for tax purposes as required by law. The winner is solely responsible for reporting and paying any and all applicable taxes related to the prize and for paying any expenses associated with a prize which is not specifically provided for in these Official Rules. The winner may be required to provide DFCI with valid identification and a valid taxpayer identification number or social security number before the prize will be awarded. Any person winning over \$600 in prizes from DFCI may receive an IRS form 1099 shortly following the end of the calendar year and a copy of such form will be filed with the IRS. Any person winning \$5,000 or more in prizes from DFCI may be required to pay the applicable taxes to DFCI before any prize will be awarded, per IRS regulations.

By participating in the contest described above, participants agree to abide by all terms of these Official Rules and all decisions of DFCI, made in its sole discretion, which decisions shall be final. DFCI will interpret these

Official Rules and will resolve any disputes, conflicting claims or ambiguities concerning the rules or the drawing, and DFCI's decisions concerning such disputes shall be final.

All participants, their heirs, executors and administrators, waive, release and forever discharge DFCI, all sponsoring entities, their respective trustees, directors, officers, employees, and agents, from all claims of liability, damages and rights of action of whatever nature or description, in equity or at law, present and future, that may arise out of or relate to participation in the Golf Ball Drop, including the use of any prize.

DFCI is not responsible for lost or stolen prizes, incorrect or inaccurate transcription of entry information, for any human error, technical malfunctions, lost/delayed data transmission, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, theft or destruction or unauthorized access to, or alteration of, entries, for line failures or other failures of any telephone network, server, providers, computer equipment, software or any combination thereof, for inability to access any web site or online service or any other error or malfunction, or for late, lost, illegible, misdirected or incomplete entries which may limit a participant's ability to participate in the Golf Ball Drop. DFCI is not responsible for technical, hardware or software failures of any kind, lost or unavailable network connections or failed, incomplete, garbled or delayed transmissions.

The contest is governed by the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. By participating in the contest, each participant consents to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts located in Suffolk County, Massachusetts, for resolution of all disputes.
