WINTER ESCAPE DRAW – RULES And REGULATIONS

How to Enter

1. The contest starts at 12:01 a.m. EST on Monday February 1st, 2010 (the “Contest Start Date”) and ends at 11:59 p.m. EST on Wednesday March 31st, 2010 (the “Contest Close Date”).
2. NO PURCHASE NECESSARY: Submit your entry form online at heartandstroke.ca/HELP or call your local Heart and Stroke Foundation office. The entry is only valid if all of the required fields have been filled. Entries are limited to one (1) entry per person for The Heart Month 2010, Grand Prize Draw. Deadline for entry 11.59pm, March 31st, 2010

Duplicate entries will be void and will disqualify the original entry.

Eligibility

1. This contest is only open to residents of British Columbia., Saskatchewan, Alberta, Ontario and Nova Scotia who have reached the age of majority except for employees of the Heart and Stroke Foundation (in any of the participating provinces), their affiliates, their advertising and promotional agencies, and any persons with whom they are domiciled.
2. To be eligible, entrants will be required to have completed their door to door canvass or Captain’s duties, by returning the kits and funds raised to the Captain and/or local Heart and Stroke Foundation office. Online Canvassers (those who raised funds online) must raise funds during the 2010 Heart Month Campaign to be eligible.

The Prize

There is one (1) “Grand Prize” that includes:

- (i) a \$5,000.00 Winter Escape travel package, provided in the form of a \$5,000.00 Travel Gift Certificate from a pre-selected Travel Company, to be used by the winner to set up their own travel plans.
- (ii) a \$5,000.00 donation to their local Heart Month campaign, provided as a contribution to the local campaign office. There is no taxable benefit to the winner.

The approximate total value of the grand prize is ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00)

Odds of Winning

The Draw

1. A random draw will be held at the Provincial Office of the Heart and Stroke Foundation of Ontario, from all of the entries received.
The “Grand Prize” draw will take place on Thursday April 15th, 2010 at 2pm EST.
The Winner will be contacted by email or phone within 14 days of the draw date.
Participants do not need to be present in order to win.

One (1) entry will be drawn from those eligible for the “Grand Prize” Draw, and who have entered the “Grand Prize” Draw by March 31st, 2010, will be eligible to win that prize.

The selected entrant will be required to sign a standard declaration and release form confirming compliance with the contest rules, acceptance of the prize as awarded and releasing the contest suppliers from all liability.
